



## Montclair Fire Department - Request for Fire Watch

The Fire Chief of the Montclair Fire Department, or his designee, has the authority to act within his direction to assign members of the Fire Department not scheduled for regular duty to render special services as a Firefighter. Special services are defined as those services of a Firefighter requested and paid for by a private person, licensee or entity.

To that end, a request is hereby being made by the applicant utilizing this detail request form.

Applicant understands they will be charged \$67.88 per Firefighter per hour, and \$102.36 per apparatus per hour, which includes all associated costs.

I understand that the minimum charge for special service shall be two (2) hours regardless of the hours worked. I also understand that I will be charged a minimum of two (2) hours if a request is cancelled with less than six (6) hours notice prior to the scheduled start time. The employing party shall remit directly to Extra Duty Solutions the full amount due for services rendered by Firefighters, either through established escrow accounts or prior payment check. All checks shall be made payable to the Extra Duty Solutions.

Firefighters shall be subject to the Rules and Regulations of the Montclair Fire Department while performing such special services. They shall not engage in any activity which could be considered a private benefit to the private person, licensee or entity requesting special service.

The Fire Chief or his designee shall have the authority to order any Firefighter engaged in a special assignment within the Township of Montclair, to respond to any emergency situation occurring within the Township of Montclair. The Fire Chief or his designee shall also have the right to order any special assignment terminated whenever said assignment creates an unacceptable risk to the health, safety and welfare of the Firefighter or the citizens of the Township of Montclair.

In any situation where a Firefighter is performing a special assignment and is called to an emergency situation, said private person, licensee or entity shall not be responsible for payment of the Firefighter's hourly rate until such as said Firefighter returns to the special assignment.
